

Master's Degree Programme in Digital Health

Instructions for applicant:

1. Fill in the application form at www.studyinfo.fi. Application period is from 18 March to 1 April 2020. The application period ends on 1 April at 3 pm Finnish time.
2. Write the preliminary task according to instructions given, use Word: margins 2, font Arial, size 12, line spacing 1.5. The maximum length of the preliminary task is five pages (5).
3. Write your name and the date of birth to the preliminary task.
4. When the preliminary task is ready, upload it to your application form in pdf-format.

You can upload the preliminary task to your application form at the same time you are filling in the application form.

You can also return to your application form later and upload the preliminary task by 8 April at 3 pm Finnish time at the latest:

- either by logging into the My Studyinfo at www.studyinfo.fi by using Finnish bank identification codes or mobile certificate
- or by using the link in the confirmation email you have received from Studyinfo when filling in the application form.

It is not possible to submit the preliminary task after the deadline.

Results of the student selection will be announced by 8 July 2020.

Instructions for the preliminary task

Master's Degree Programme in Digital Health

Studying on the Master's Degree Programme in Digital Health, is for those who are developers, interested in 'health tech' environments and interdisciplinary work, and who are willing to encounter new professional challenges. The focus is on modern and innovative methods, research, development and innovations in the social and health care field, business and administration, engineering and entrepreneurship in the context of Health Care and Social Welfare.

The preliminary task has two parts:

I. Personal development (30 p). Answer to the following questions:

A. Why do you want to study and work as a Master in Digital Health (20 points)?

B. What are your existing competences and interests when thinking of this master degree?
Describe your key competences. If you have working experience related to digitalization, please describe that, too (10 points).

II. Working life development: Your idea of the thesis work (max. 70 points)

The programme has the thesis part which is 30 ECTS and around 800 hours work. Most commonly, the idea of thesis originates from working life e.g. one's own workplace, organization.

Describe your development and/or research idea, which supports both your professional development and your working life setting. Write your idea, why it is important, what is the target organization/setting, and add your arguments why you choose this topic.
Finally describe how you conduct your thesis work and delineate a rough schedule.

Use report form e.g. cover sheet, content and references related to your thesis idea.
